The first event this newly formed entity will be hosting is the 2024 Culpeper Cycling Century and Tour in Culpeper, Virginia on October 5th.

2024 marks the 17th year the Culpeper Cycling Century will traverse the roads in Culpeper County following 100-, 60-, and 30-mile routes. With the continued help and support of Culpeper Parks and Recreation during this transition year, the start/finish location will remain the same, utilizing the recently constructed Fieldhouse.

The formation of an events branch of Blue Ridge Cyclery is something Tevendale saw as a "natural progression" for the company that was founded in 2010 in Charlottesville, VA. Along with supplying bikes, accessories, and service—adding events to the lineup proactively gives "Virginia cyclists something to participate in and look forward to."
